

Student Academic Services  
2010-2011 Indicators of Success

- Academic Skills Center: Participation in Study Skills Seminars increased by 14.6% as compared with 2009-10 with 85 seminars for 1,912 students; 90.8% satisfaction rate.
- Supplemental Workshops in Math: 661 enrolled; 86.8% A/B/C rate; 96.7 % satisfaction rate.
- Supplemental Workshops in Science: 1,109 enrolled; 91.0% A/B/C rate; 98.7% satisfaction rate.
- Study Session Program: 1,874 participants; 86% A/B/C rate; 99% satisfaction rate.
- Educational Opportunity Program: 383 undergrads and 11\* BMS students with 45 graduates (11% of EOP enrollment).
- Student Support Services: 261 undergrads and 7\* BMS students with 32 graduates (12% of SSS enrollment).
- Partners Program: 1,474 undergrads and 16\* BMS students with 97 graduates (6% of Partners Program enrollment). Cal Poly began tracking students from all Partner schools in 2009; most participants are second year or less).
- Educational Talent Search: 600 students at 9 schools, with 67 graduating seniors (11% of ETS enrollment).
- Upward Bound: 87 students at 5 schools with 31 graduating seniors (35.6% of UB enrollment).
