

Student Support Services Program at Cal Poly

The Federal TRIO Programs (TRIO) are funded through the Department of Education and are outreach and student services programs designed to identify and provide services to low-income and first-generation college students to progress through the academic pipeline from middle school to post-baccalaureate programs.

Student Support Services program (SSS), a federally funded TRIO program of U.S. Department of Education, is funded to serve 250 Cal Poly students. The program is designed to assist students whom are low-income and/or first-generation college students and/or students with disabilities with enhancing their academic skills, increase their retention and graduation rates and promote graduate and professional school programs.

2012-13 Outcomes

The Cal Poly Student Support Services Program achieved an 85% persistence rate in the 2012-13 project year.

The Cal Poly Student Support Services Program achieved an 80% good academic standing rate in the 2012-13 project year.

The Cal Poly Student Support Services Program achieved a 70% six-year graduation rate in the 2012-13 project year.
