Our first full day of activities for our participants involves high and low ropes team building exercises through ASI's Chumash Challenge. During these activities administrative staff and residential staff will be observing the communication between participants and leadership development among the assigned groups. This one activity is designed to elicit these actions and outcomes and we will note what we observe for assessment purposes. In addition to our own observations we have time allotted for "reflection time" where students will jot down on a journal what they took away from their experience and in their own words will describe the take away lessons from the day. Summer participants will have this "reflection time" after every large scale event that we put together for them and for their own free write purposes as well. We will collect the journals at the end of the summer for transcribing and for assessment purposes.
