



UPWARD BOUND

Upward Bound (UB) is a federally funded pre-college program that helps prepare low-income and first generation students achieve their dream of going to college.

Each year, UB serves 95 students from four high schools: Ernest Righetti, Pioneer Valley, Santa Maria, and Nipomo.

During the summer, 45 participants in grades 10, 11, 12 are selected to attend a 6-week Summer Academy: four weeks of a residential component on Cal Poly campus to give students a "college like" experience.
